2022 was a very creative and varied year at VIMÖ and VIMÖ Vienna and our counseling center VarGes!

The book "Inter\* Pride — Perspectives from a worldwide human rights movement" was published in May, which was produced with strong participation of VIMÖ. From the summer on, VIMÖ Vienna worked intensively on the theater play "INTER\*Story — a piece of activism" which had its premiere in November. At the same time, VIMÖ Vienna was finally able to move into its first office at the Cultural Center 4lthangrund, Augasse 2-6 in 1090 Wien, which means that VarGes now has its own consulting space in Vienna. The space was of course furnished more and more over the next months and as it should be for an intersectional cultural center, we also participate in the regular meetings that take place with all using groups to create a good common place for all.

Another highlight was the **Intersex Awareness Day**, where the 3 new videos on "Intersex", "Human Rights and Activism" and on "VIMÖ – Association of intersex people Austria" were presented in in <u>Austrian Sign Language</u> which were made in cooperation with Barbara Schuster and can be found on the homepage since then. A very important start for us for stronger networking and accessibility of our offers and contents.

There was another exciting **award** in 2022, this time related to participatory research on our counseling center VarGes!


We also worked on new materials (see below). Especially the brochure <u>"Sex & Gender Diversity in Companies - A Guide for Working with Inter\*, Trans\* and Non-Binary People"</u> was an important project, which was also presented at a large networking event with the cooperation partners ERSTE Group and IBM in Vienna in June 2022. We designed and printed flyers for the educational and consulting services of VarGes. We also contributed to the German version of OII Europe's <u>"Supporting your intersex child – A Parents' Toolkit"</u>, which will be published in 2023.



2022 also meant a partial farewell: **Tobias Humer** left the board after 8 successful years together and also ended his employment at VIMÖ Vienna at the end of the year to dedicate himself to new personal goals. **Noah Rieser** took a temporary break at VIMÖ at the same time. However, both remain with VIMÖ as active members - Tobias Humer in networking and working on political agendas, just as a new part of the Steering Board of OII Europe as well as a peer counselor to VarGes and Noah Rieser as Vice Chairperson of VIMÖ Vienna. We thank them very much for all they have done and achieved for VIMÖ and intersex people and their families in Austria in the last years!

This also resulted in a **new board** at VIMÖ: Tinou Ponzer is now Chairperson, Magdalena Klein is Vice Chairperson and Luan Pertl is Secretary.

In 2022 we also have a new member: **Charlotte Wunn** started her job as coordinator for our educational trainings at the VarGes project in January 2022 and has since become a very important part of VIMÖ, VIMÖ Vienna and VarGes.

## **Community work and Networking**

In 2022, we were fortunately able to organize meetings in presence for the intersex community again, but of course did not want to completely abandon online meetings. In addition, we invited through our network to international meetings, such as those organized by our umbrella organization OII Europe or



German-speaking meetings of OII Germany or Intergeschlechtliche Menschen e.V., these included for example the Online OII Europe Community Event from 30<sup>th</sup> September to 2<sup>nd</sup> October 2022. The intersex community in Austria came together more in 2022 at public events such as the Inter\*Pride book presentations and the play performances, as well as at the Pride events in June, at the Vienna Pride and the Linz Pride. VIMÖ also participated at the Europride and the associated human rights conference in Belgrade in the fall. There was again a VIMÖ info table at the "Villa Vida Street Festival" in May 2022, as well as at the "Queer Feminist Festival" on 24th September 2022, both organized by the Community Café Villa Vida and both opportunities where the important networking with the local/regional LGBTIQA\* community, first and foremost the trans and non-binary community and their associations Venib – Verein Nicht-Binär, Cha(i)nge – Trans Peer Group Vienna und TransX could take place.

As always, VIMÖ networks the Inter\* community with monthly newsletters, provides updates on common issues, and invites them to events.

At our inter\* meetings, relatives and parents, who also see themselves as part of the overarching community and enrich our meetings, were also invited and present.

The project "Community- and Capacitybuilding of the inter\* Community" of VIMÖ Vienna, which was successfully approved by the City of Vienna, was prepared in 2022 and the offer will be implemented in 2023, which we are already looking forward to. More about this in the next annual report, of course!

## **Advocacy and Policy work**

The draft law from the **Ministry of Justice** on the ban of non-consensual and unnecessary medical interventions on children and adolescents with variations of sex characteristics, expected for 2022, unfortunately did not come. We will work to ensure that the government implements appropriate child protection and rights in 2023!

Apart from that, we have attended several valuable **networking** events, for example with <u>100% Sport</u>, or the Austrian Chamber of Labor on the topic <u>"Why (again) promoting women\*".</u> In 2020, the city of Linz became part of the <u>Rainbow Cities Network</u>, followed by the **cooperation** with the local associations of the LGBTIQA\* community in 2022. VIMÖ is a member of this working group and has implemented the change of the Prideflag to the Progess Prideflag within the city of Linz. Furthermore, we were involved in important **surveys**, on the one hand in the Expert Advisory Board for <u>Gesundheit</u> <u>Österreich GmbH</u>, which conducted a study on the health of LGBTIQ people in Austria for the first time, and on the other hand for the <u>European Commission</u>, which conducted an EU-wide study on the situation of intersex people and their parents.

Internationally we also were in good **exchange** with LGBTIQA\*-, especially the Inter\*-organizations, e.g. at the <u>ILGA Europe</u> conference in Sofia in October and again contributed our expertise on the human rights situation of intersex people in Austria to the <u>ILGA Europe Rainbow Map and Annual Report</u>. Of course, as every year, we also contributed to the <u>OII Europe Good Practice Map</u> with our current projects and achievements.

Furthermore, we published two statements, on the one hand on the still very poor **implementation of** the alternative gender markers and on the other hand on the (non-)recognition of sex/gender diversity, after media and political discussions on this increased strongly over the summer, also within the LGBTIQ community, whereby equal rights, equal treatment or even the existence of trans, inter\* and non-binary people was sometimes questioned and instead presented as a threat. (Both statements are linked at the Media item.) We expect to do a lot of education work on this in 2023 as well, and to work hard for visibility and support for our causes.

## **Organizational development**

In 2022, we entered the final phase of our organizational development process. We continued to receive professional support from <a href="Fanja Haybach">Fanja Haybach</a> and <a href="Sarah Mayr">Sarah Mayr</a>. This included - in addition to coordination meetings and communication to coordinate the content - an online supervision appointment, a workshop on "Grasping Organization" at Willy\*Fred in Linz, a conclave on "Giving Space To Change" at Schlosspark Mauerbach, a workshop on "Shaping Leadership" at Kulturzentrum 4lthangrund in Vienna and an online final meeting for January 2023. We are very grateful for the

valuable support in the last 3 years and with this richly gained basis we will be able to go well into the continuous independent development of our organizational structure.

# **Peer Counseling on Variations of Sex Characteristics (VSC)**

7 peer counselors conducted about 90 counseling sessions in 2022, by phone, email and video chat, but some also took place in person again, e.g. already in the new counseling room in the VIMÖ Vienna office. In addition, there were regular counseling intervision



sessions and several online meetings of the active team. This team consisted of a **total of 11 peer counselors** based in Vienna, Upper Austria, Tyrol and Berlin. In 2022, the focus was more on dealing with the counseling concept and developing it specifically for the VarGes counseling center. This process will continue in 2023, as the counselors all work on a voluntary basis and it was determined that the content development in the online format was less suitable and more face-to-face meetings were needed. From 17th to 18th December 2022, a conclave meeting of the peer counseling team took place in Vienna in the premises of the Cultural Center 4lthangrunds to reflect on, organize and further develop the joint counseling activities.



One of the LGBTIQ research awards of Pride Biz Austria went to Nicole Gebhart / Paul Haller / Sonja Huber / Julia Steiner / Tinou Ponzer / Tobias Humer in November 2022 for their work "'Working on a VSC reinforcing level' - About the peer counseling understanding of the Counseling Center for Variations of Sex Characteristics VAR.GES. Participatory research report with hints for research practice and impulses for social work". This is a research group of the University of Applied Sciences Social Work Sankt Pölten, which together with co-researchers of our counseling center have illuminated aspects of participatory research, peer counseling and peer counseling specifically on variations of sex characteristics over 2 years. Last year, a broad scientific advisory board selected and chose these and 5 other research papers from 55 submissions. We congratulate all winners and thank Pride Biz Austria, the sponsors and of course the student group, whose initiative filled gaps in the research on peer counseling and variations of sex characteristics with more scientific knowledge and exemplary practice!

# **Educational work & Consulting**





Our team was able to conduct a total of **50 workshops, trainings or lectures** in 2022 - online, but also much again in presence. We continued to give a high proportion of our workshops in the health sector and in sexual education training (for example for <a href="SexOlogisch">SexOlogisch</a> and <a href="Lil\*">Lil\*</a>). Consulting appointments also took place, e.g. for the Austrian Federal Railways (ÖBB). Due to the publication of our guide for companies in June (see materials), there were more inquiries from the field of labor and personnel management. Some workshops were booked by agencies of the Public Employment Service Austria (AMS - Arbeitsmarktservice), which we are very pleased about. At the same time, the focus on sports also increased and, at the invitation of 100% Sport, we were able to sensitize the gender representatives of the Austrian sports associations to intersex/VSC. The topic of language and sex/gender diversity was also addressed, for example, in cooperation with the <a href="Department of Human Resources Development">Department of Human Resources Development</a>, Gender & Diversity Management at Johannes Kepler University in Linz. In addition, we were again involved in various professional contributions on the topic and accompanied scientific work of students, for example, through the involvement in the ongoing course of Persson Perry Baumgartinger on Trans\_Inter\*Nonbinary in Social Work, at the University of Applied Sciences in Vienna.

The VarGes education team, consisting of 4 educational trainers and the education coordinator, met regularly online to organize and coordinate the education work and to exchange and reflect on the content and improve the offerings. Compared to previous years, it was gratifying to see that the educational offerings in 2022 lasted longer on average, which allowed for a more in-depth study of the topic. Due to the theater project at VIMÖ Vienna, which also intensively involved most of the educational trainers (more on this in the Events section), a few educational inquiries were postponed to 2023.

Through a grant from the Federal Ministry of Social Affairs, Health, Care and Consumer Protection, which began in the fall of 2022, three part-time positions could be created or secured in order to involve health and social professional groups in focus groups, to offer awareness training for them and to develop materials such as toolkits in order to convey the needs of people with variations of sex characteristics in these areas in a specific, exchange and practice-oriented manner until 2024.

### **Events**




The events in 2022 had a strong focus on the anthology "Inter\* Pride - Perspectives from a worldwide human rights movement", edited by Paul Haller, Luan Pertl and Tinou Ponzer, and a project of VIMÖ,

PIÖ and HOSI Salzburg. In addition, there were 12 book presentations (online and in presence), book tables of VIMÖ at several events such as the Autumn Festival of the Cultural Center 4lthangrund or in the main library of Vienna in the context of the "16 days against violence against women", as well as 5 interviews and 6 book reviews. An overview is also available at the publishing house worten & meer. The book brings together over 30 authors, interview partners and contributions from 6 continents on the topic of intersex activism, some of whom also contributed to a video. We thank everyone who made participated in this unique book project and it possible!



On 22<sup>nd</sup> November 2022 "INTER\*Story - a piece of activism" was premiered in Vienna. There were a total of 4 performances (22nd, 24th-26th of November), which were not only all sold out, but also received very positive feedback from the audience. The play was a production of VIMÖ Vienna in cooperation with WERK X-Petersplatz in 1010 Vienna. In the setting of a TV talk show, the intersex actors shared their own stories and experiences from activism. We benefited from the methodological know-how from the theater field of Magdalena Klein, who was also a performer in the role of the talk show host. The play was accompanied by multimedia elements, a lovingly designed backdrop and an exhibition by Alex Jürgen\*. We thank the entire team of the production, on site, and all who accompanied the project and of course the sponsors who funded this special project. However, it is not over yet, in 2023 the film documentation of the play will celebrate its premiere.

Members of VIMÖ and VarGes have also participated in other public events or held them as well as organized them in cooperation with other organizations - these can be found under "Termine (Dates)" on the homepage.


